Mayor Dial called the meeting to order with limited seating and broadcasted on YouTube Live at 6:30 pm. The public was invited to watch. Council Member Howard attended virtually.

Approval of Agenda

Council Member Furr made a motion to approve the agenda.

Council Member Hill seconded the motion. Motion was approved 3-0.

Public Hearing

Discussion on the millage rate of the Town of Tyrone for fiscal year 2020-2021.

Brandon Perkins, Town Manager

Ms. Beach shared that staff was proposing for the thirteenth year in a row maintaining the millage rate at 2.889. She added that if a home was assessed at \$325,000, the annual taxes would reflect an increase of \$9.98. Non-homestead was assessed at the same value of \$325,000, reflecting an annual increase of \$10.14. The Town's proposed increase in property tax revenue amounts to \$80,781 at 6.23%. Ms. Beach stated that the total amount of dollars anticipated to be collected in property tax for 2020 was \$1,377,337.

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Mayor Dial asked if the property amount was random. Ms. Beach stated that the \$325,000 is the average Tyrone home value from last year.

Mayor Dial opened the public hearing for anyone that wished to speak in support of the proposed millage rate of 2.889. No one spoke.

Mayor Dial opened the public hearing for anyone that wished to speak in opposition. No one spoke.

Ms. Beach announced that the next millage public hearing would be held August 26, 2020, at 9:00 am and the millage adoption would be held on August 26, 2020, at 4:00 pm.

Adjournment

Council Member Furr made a motion to adjourn. Motion was approved 3-0. Meeting adjourned at 6:36 pm.
