Ms. Beach informed everyone that this was the thirteenth-year staff proposed the millage rate to remain at 2.889 mills. She shared that the Tax Assessor valued homes higher this year than last. The average Tyrone home was valued at approximately \$325,000, taxes would be \$369.75, which is \$9.98 over last year. She added that the no-homestead average was also \$325,000, which would be \$375.75, an increase of \$1014 from last year.
